TYPES OF SUPPORT:

Foster (resource) families receive support from The Neighborhood volunteers, over a six-month period, in these three ways:



Meals are delivered twice **monthly**



Random acts of kindness such as mowing the lawn, a special delivery of coffee, fixing a broken swing set, helping with household chores, and more (these are left up to the creativity of the Neighborhood team)



Relationship and partnership are developed between these caring community volunteers and foster (resource) families through encouragement and emotional support
